

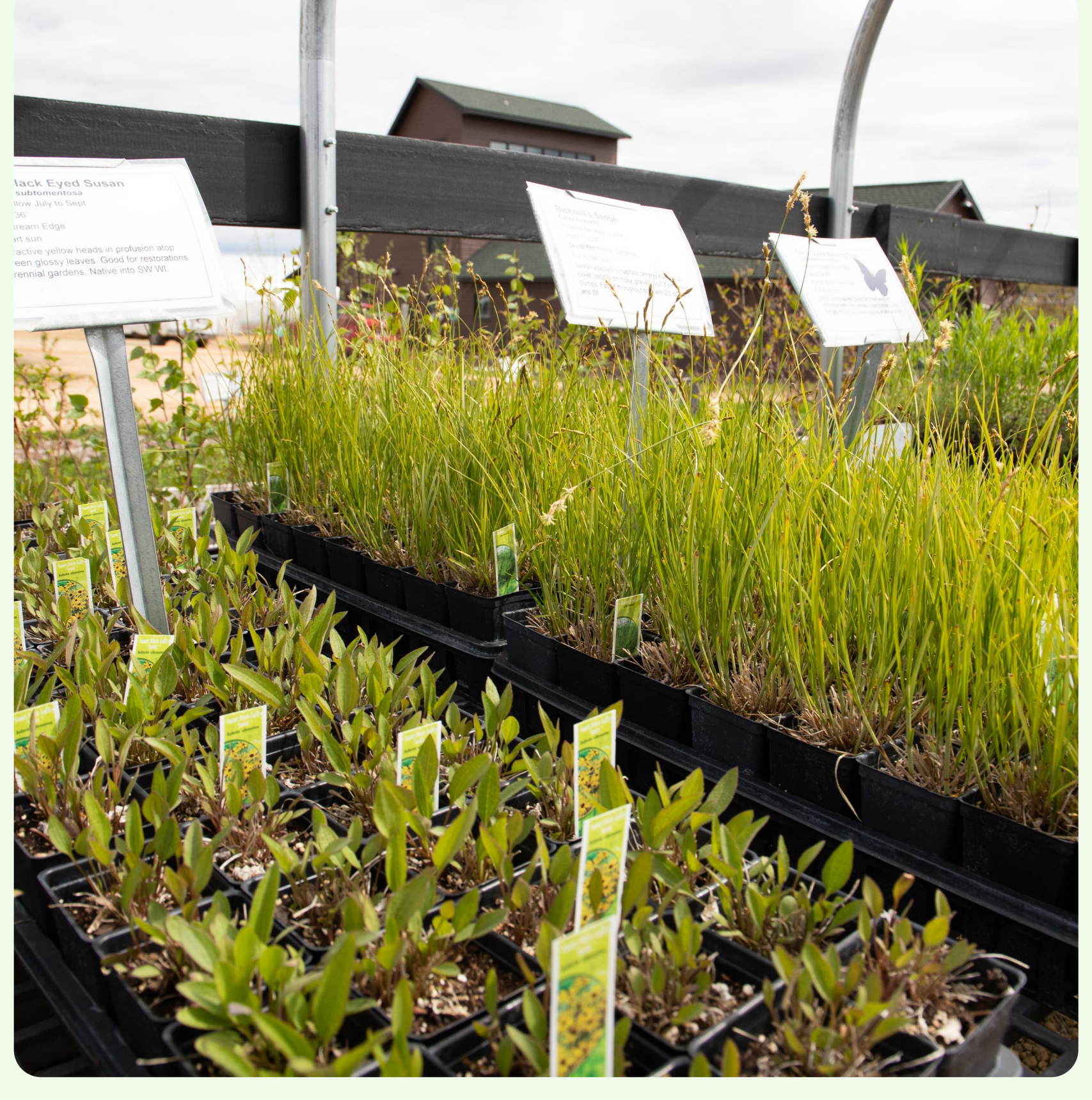

4 to 8 Hours of Sun

[Full Sun](#)

Areas with 4 to 8 hours of direct sunlight are considered part sun to part shade. Sites with closer to 8 hours of light can also pick species from the full sun list. Shadier areas can also use species from the shade list of corresponding soil moisture.
